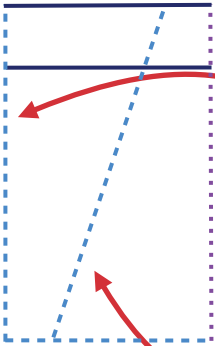


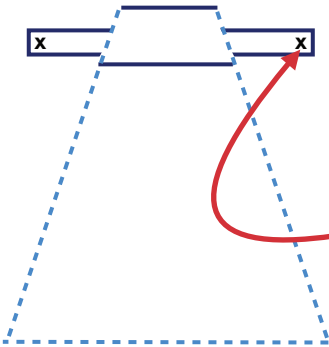


# Hero Cape!

## PILLOW CASE CAPE



- Flatten out a pillowcase on your work surface.
- Cut out seam on the bottom of the pillowcase and up one side.
- Measure out neck width and cut a diagonal line from that measurement down to the bottom of the piece of fabric.



- Unfold the cape and thread a piece of 1 to 2-inch ribbon through the edge of the pillowcase.
- Attach velcro dots to either end of the ribbon to secure the closure.
- Decorate your cape to make it your own!

### YOU WILL NEED:

- One pillowcase
- A piece of Fabric Ribbon 1" or larger
- Self-Sticking Velcro Strips
- Scissors
- Chalk
- Decorative materials such as fabric paint, fabric pens, items to sew or glue on, felt, sequins, etc.

### KEY:

- natural fold line
- (re) fold line
- cut line

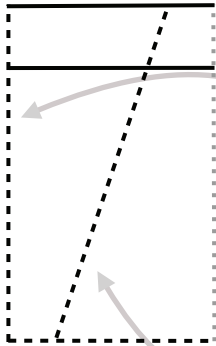

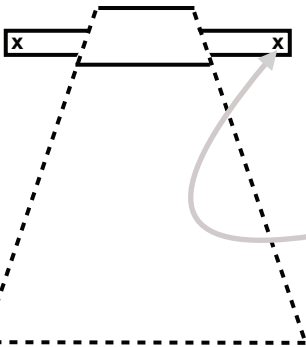


# Hero Cape!

## PILLOW CASE CAPE
